

PPPA Directed To Increase Efficiency, Attract More Investment

ISLAMABAD: Minister for Planning, Development and Special Initiatives Asad Umar on Wednesday directed the Public-Private Partnership Authority (PPPA) to come up with well-structured partnerships for attracting more investment and increasing their efficiency.
